

## INTRODUCING THE NEW GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN GIFTED EDUCATION

Millersville University is pleased to announce the creation of a new Graduate Certificate in Gifted Education. The new program will begin in the fall semester 2010.

The certificate program will be delivered in two formats to enhance convenience and access for interested students. The certificate will be delivered as a fully online distance education program and can be completed in four semesters with offerings year-round (fall, spring and summer). Students also have the option of taking courses in a blended, accelerated format (Friday evening and Saturday, face-to-face meetings) at our downtown Lancaster campus.

The complete certificate (15 credits) can be applied in its entirety towards the requirements for the Masters of Education degree in Gifted Education. The certificate can also be pursued as a post-masters certificate for those students who have already earned a masters degree.

### **Certificate Requirements\***

#### **I. Required Courses (15 credits)**

The required courses will be offered on a rotating basis.

**GFED 670:** Psychology of the Gifted (3cr)

**GFED 674:** Programming for the Gifted (3cr)

**GFED 675:** Evaluating Instructional Effectiveness: Application for the Gifted (3cr)

**GFED 690:** Clinical Practicum (6cr)

*The Practicum could run across two semesters, in which case time-to-completion would be five semesters.*

*\*You must be a currently certified educator (Instructional I) to enroll in this program.*
