### Publication/Technology Committee:

#### Co-chaired by Directors of Publication and Technology

The Publication/Technology Committee shall:

- Review and edit PAGE's publications including the *UPDATE*, *Bulletin*, website and any other forms of communications for public distribution impacting the Association and its policies.
  - We are looking to continue to strengthen our *UPDATE*, *Bulletin*, and other forms of communications (Constant Contact, Website, etc.).
  - We are looking to increase communication/networking using a variety of social media (Facebook, Twitter, etc.)
- A member of the Executive Committee and Editors of publications serve on this Committee.
  - Members meet periodically face-to-face, via Skype, email, Facebook, and/or phone conference (meetings may occur by region)

### Legislative Committee:

#### Chaired by Legislative Liaison

The Legislative Committee shall:

- Review any proposed state and federal legislation and regulations related to or impacting the education of gifted students.
- After review of any proposed legislation, the Legislative Committee shall prepare recommended comments or testimony to be submitted to legislators, legislative committees, the State Board of Education or officials of the Department of Education.
- Keep abreast of pressing issues in gifted education at the State and Federal levels and write Read and Reacts to be disseminated to PAGE members, as needed.
- Initiate and coordinate efforts to lobby state and federal elected officials.

### PAGE Regional Outreach Committee (Ad-hoc):

#### Co-chaired by State Affiliate Director and Regional Affiliate Coordinator (2-year rotation of regional coordinators)

The PAGE Regional Outreach Committee will serve to increase member contact for parents and/or educators who support appropriate education for gifted students in Pennsylvania. Networking will be facilitated through regional (eastern, central, and western) communications and programming for parents, educators, and students.

The Regional Outreach Committee shall:

- Recognize the needs within each region.
- Support the expansion of Affiliate Chapters (Parent and Educator) within each region.
- Provide outreach to rural areas within each region.
- Facilitate communications and programming within each region.
- Cultivate support for gifted education within each region.
- Sponsor/facilitate regional events and activities for students and parents.

**Marketing/Development Committee (Ad-hoc):**

**Chaired by the Director of Advancement**

The Marketing/Development Committee shall:

- Evaluate potential marketing needs and resources.
- Identify ways to get message out about who PAGE is – brand awareness,
  - Write and circulate press releases
  - Oversee social media in collaboration with Director of Technology – Facebook, Twitter
- Write grants.
- Secure sponsorships.
- Assist in advertising/promoting PAGE events, such as regional and state conferences.
