Her Foundation has helped families with Christmas meals, gifts, gas and grocery cards as patients are going through treatments. She has donated her own hair 3 times to help cancer patients. In addition, Ms. Battah has contributed to her school community in a variety of roles each year. Her compassion, responsibility, and hard work have helped many people.

2016 Distinguished Student Grades 10-12 – Erica Wang, Hershey High School

Born in Hershey, PA, Erica Wang has been involved with gifted education since 1st grade. Erica spearheaded the Hershey High School Key Club's first Walk for Clean Water, which raised \$18K for Thirst Project, a nonprofit organization. As an intern at the Penn State College of Medicine Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, she used R programming language to analyze the genetics of mice exposed to bladder cancer carcinogen.
